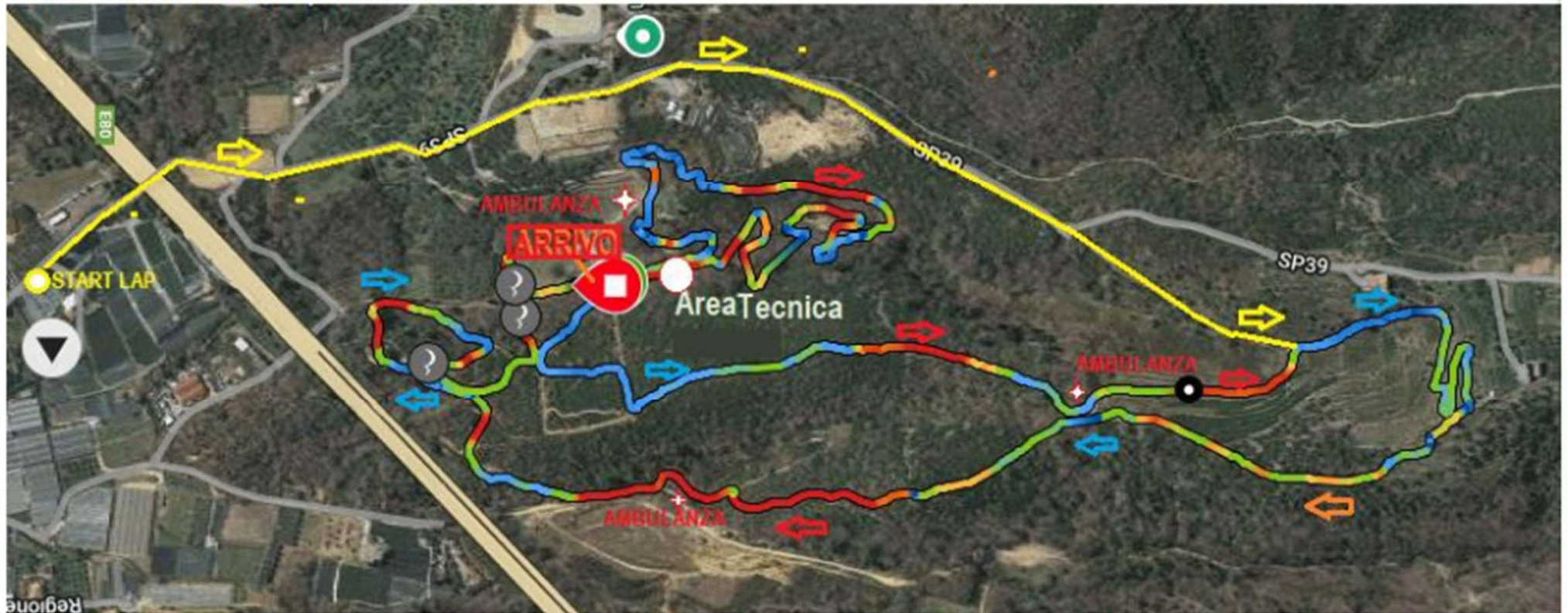

Lap : 4.4 km

F/TZ : double –
access only with pass

Start & Finish line are NOT in the same place

Boxes closing time	09:00 (15 min before the start)
Start	09:15
Number of Laps	5 laps
Podium	Top 5

- Race configuration – Men Under 23

Boxes closing time	11:00 (15 min before the start)
Start	11:15
Number of Laps	6 laps
Podium	Top 5

- Race configuration – Women Elite

Boxes closing time	13:00 (15 min before the start)
Start	13:15
Number of Laps	5 laps
Podium	Top 5

- Race configuration – Women Junior

Boxes closing time	13:00 (15 min before the start)
Start	13:17
Number of Laps	4 laps
Podium	Top 5

- Race configuration – Men Elite

Boxes closing time	15:00 (15 min before the start)
Start	15:15
Number of Laps	7 laps
Podium	Top 5

- Race procedures –

80 %

- In effect Men Junior, Men U23 and Men Elite race
- Located 100 m before the finish line

- Race procedures –

Feed & Tech Zone

- One double feed and tech zone
- Access only with F&T zone pass
- Assistant stay behind the line (tape on ground)

- Rules reminders – Cameras

- Allowed only in training
- **No camera during races** (only if requested by TV)

- Rules reminders -

- Number plate & back number well fixed
- No plate cutting
- No sleeveless jersey
- No compression clothing
- One foot down for the start
- Feed needs to be done from hand to hand; no touching the rider
- Technical assistance only when the rider is stopped, with minimum one foot down
- No technical assistance outside the tech zones

- Awards ceremony -

- Top 5 for all UCI races
- Will be held as soon as each race arrives



- Prize money -

- Paid by bank transfer



- Antidoping information -

A certain amount of controls will be conducted under NADO ITA.
